

## EMPLOYMENT VISA-DEPENDENT EMPLOYMENT

1	<b>Application form for a visa for a long stay in Greece</b> , fully filled in and signed by the applicant.
2	<b>One recent passport-size photograph</b> in colour with white background, according to the relevant specifications laid down by ICAO.
3	<b>Passport</b> , which should : -be of a validity exceeding by three months the ending date of the visa length -include at least two blank pages -have been issued within the previous ten years.
4	<b>Prefecture' s Approval</b> for the provision of dependent employment to a specific employer in Greece
5	Certified copy of the <b>employment contract</b> or original "Ypefthini dilosi" of the employer, duly attested by a Greek Public Authority, showing: -the kind and the period of the employment -that the remuneration of the applicant is at least equivalent to the monthly salary of unskilled workers. <b>The employment contract and the Prefecture's Approval are sent directly to the Consular Office, which, after receiving them, calls the applicant to sign the contract and submit his application.</b>
6	Travel medical insurance covering at least the period of validity of the visa requested. The insurance policy should cover any eventual expenses relating to repatriation for medical reasons, urgent medical attention and/or emergency hospital treatment. Important information for applications lodged in India: as of 01/10/2013, a travel medical insurance will be accepted only if it is issued by one of the insurance companies mentioned in the list of approved companies. <a href="#">"All about our visas"</a>
7	<b>Police Clearance Certificate</b> , recent and duly attested *
8	<b>Medical Fitness Certificate</b> , upon request by the Consular Office after the Interview (see Note no 2)

- \* - For India: the document must be affixed with an Apostille Sticker from the Ministry of External Affairs New Delhi  
 - For Bangladesh: the document must be attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Bangladesh, Dhaka  
 - For Nepal: the document must be attested by a) the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Nepal, Kathmandu and b) the Honorary Consulate of Greece in Kathmandu *or* the Embassy of Nepal in New Delhi  
 - For Sri Lanka: the document must be attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Sri Lanka, Colombo

### Note:

- 1) *Original documents and passport submitted must be accompanied along with a copy*
- 2) *All documents submitted, if not in Greek or English, should be accompanied by an English translation*
- 3) *The applicant may be asked for additional documents*

- 5) *The visa fee is not refunded if the visa is refused.*
